**Child Support
and
Arrearage Guidelines**

Effective August 1, 1999

The following legislation was enacted by the Connecticut General Assembly after the promulgation of the new Child Support and Arrearage Guidelines.

PUBLIC ACT 99-279; Sec. 32

Notwithstanding the child support guidelines established pursuant to section 46b-215a of the general statutes, in cases in which an obligor is an hourly wage earner and has worked less than forty-five hours per week at the time of the establishment of the support order, any additional income earned from working more than forty-five hours per week shall not be considered income for purposes of such guidelines.
