- 4. Payment in full of the filing fee or an Order of the Court waiving payment of filing fees in forma pauperis (fee waiver application forms available at the Filing Window)
- 5. Except when applying for orders restraining or enjoining violence or harassment, plaintiffs or petitioners who are minors under 18 years of age and otherwise not emancipated must have an Order of the Court appointing an adult as a guardian ad litem to act on their behalf (Guardian ad Litem Application and Order forms available at the Forms Counter).
