## INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLIANCE WITH C.R.C.P. 26.2 REGARDING DISCLOSURE

Within 40 days of the date you file your Petition or post-decree Motion, you <u>must</u> send the other party the following papers. They must send you the same information.

- 1. A completed financial affidavit.
- 2. A complete copy of federal and state income tax returns for the three years preceding the filing of the Petition or Motion. If you have not filed for the past year, but have a W-2 form, send that form.
- 3. A complete copy of federal and state income tax returns for the three years preceding the filing of the Petition or Motion, including all schedules, for any corporation, business or partnership in which a party has an interest entitling that party to a return.
- 4. Three years of tax returns for any corporation or partnership for which you get a return.
- 5. (For self-employed parties) A sworn statement of the party's gross income, business expenses and net income (before personal taxes) for the past three months
- 6. All available information relating to pension, profit sharing, deferred compensation or retirement plans.

Send the other party the information and file the Certificate of Compliance with Rule 26.2 form and your financial affidavit with the court. <u>DO NOT FILE</u> the other information with the court, unless you are instructed to do so.
