

## ANNULMENT INSTRUCTIONS

1. Complete, sign and have notarized the following:  
Petition for Annulment
2. Complete, sign & date:  
Civil Cover Sheet
3. Then make one copy of your Petition for Annulment for your records. Two copies if your spouse wants a copy to review.
4. Have your spouse complete, sign and have notarized:  
Answer & Waiver
5. Hand deliver the following papers to the Clerk of the Court.  
Ask the clerk how hearing dates are scheduled in your County.
  - a. Civil Cover Sheet
  - b. Petition for Annulment
  - c. Answer & Waiver
  - d. Final Judgment
  - e. Final Disposition Form
6. You are now ready to schedule a hearing date.  
Go to your hearing. Dress appropriately and be sure not to be late. Be courteous. Unless instructed otherwise by the Judge,  
read through your Petition (your copy) using "I" and "me" instead of the word "Petitioner". Truthfully answer any questions the Judge asks.
